

Our Privacy Policy

The Centre for Relational Care is committed to respecting your privacy. This policy outlines our ongoing obligations regarding the collection, use, and protection of your personal information.

What is Personal Information and how do we collect it?

Personal Information is anything that can identify you, like your name, address, email, job title, employer, or phone number.

We may also collect personal stories that people choose to share with us to support our advocacy and education work.

We gather this information in different ways, including through interviews, emails, phone calls, our website, media, publications, and other public sources.

Sharing personal information

We'll always ask for your clear permission before sharing your story publicly, and you can change your mind at any time. However, once a story is out there - on social media, in reports, or in the media - we can't fully control where it goes or how others might share it. We'll do our best to manage this, but we encourage you to think about your comfort level before giving consent.

If you want to share your story but prefer to stay anonymous, we can remove or change details that might identify you. We'll also work with you to make sure your story is shared in a way that feels right for you.

Security of Personal Information

We take care to keep your personal information safe from misuse, loss, or unauthorised access. When we no longer need your information for the reason it was collected, we'll either delete it or remove any details that could identify you.

Access to your Personal Information

You have the right to see the personal information we have about you and can ask us to update or correct it at any time.
